Demolition of existing conservatory and the erection of a two storey extension to side to include first floor balcony

2 Harts Houses

Erection of garden room and associated access steps into reduced level front garden space to include provision of below ground electric cable

There had been 1 objection received – this is essentially a repeat of a previous refused application but for the removal of a chimney; concern what the garden room will be used for; contrary to Green Belt policy; no parking facilities other than one narrow space in front of the proposed plot; detriment to neighbours' residential amenity; overshadowing and loss of privacy to neighbour; negative effect on the character and appearance of the area; concern about who they would get to build the garden room (this is not a material planning consideration)

The previous application had been recommended for approval at Horwich, refused at Bolton due to the proposed development by virtue of its size, siting and design will have a detrimental effect on the openness of the Green Belt, the character and appearance of the conservation area and is contrary to policies CG3 and CG7AP of Bolton's Core Strategy.

Highways and PROW commented that electrical cable insulation for the proposed work will need to be undertaken under an appropriate street works activities permit which would need to take into consideration PROW (HOR15) which runs along Old Rake to ensure that it is fit for the public to use

Resolved to recommend refusal

Horwich Parish C of E Primary School, Church Street Listed building consent to remove internal cast iron columns to the school assembly/dining hall

There had been 1 letter of support – will enhance the school's facilities. GMAAS commented that the proposed work will not harm any known or suspected below ground remains of archaeological interest.
